




Digital Content Protection – Music Portfolio Case Study

In last 9 weeks we have detected >33k pirated media (source)files across >2k websites.



To remove pirated media files we carried out an intense exercise – >11k DMCA notices & >13k escalations across the ecosystem



Additional Emails

- Total 269 email exchanged post DMCA & escalation.





As a result we have removed >23k pirated media files & taken down 51 non-compliant websites.




In Batch 1, for example, we ensured takedown of 82% of the total source links

Cumulative Takedown Ratio – Source Links (Batch 1)




Note: Enforcement actions started in Week 3 of the project

In these 9 weeks we detected >32k infringing links containing pirated content across ~3k websites




We have notified >37k infringing web pages links to Google for search results removal.



In Batch 1, for example, there has been significant improvement in visibility of the whitelisted platforms





Pirated media takedown, and removal of pirated search engine results, has severely reduced overall accessibility to pirated content
